Summer BBQ season and Christmas function time - introducing the Potatopak range:

Managing your worm farm over summer:

For those of you that are new to worm farming, the first summer can be a challenge. Never fear - help is only a phone call or an email away.

Handy hints:

- If your worm farm looks dry or feels warm, water it gently to keep it moist but not sodden.
- To help keep the fruit flies away, cut a piece of carpet or use an old t-shirt to place on top of the food waste in the top layer.
- A healthy worm farm should not smell, if it is beginning to, mix in some leaves or other greenery, and shredded or ripped paper to add some carbon into the mix.
- A little bit of garden lime can also help re-balance the ph-levels.
